



POSITION: Non-tenured Assistant Professor

The School of Business Administration at Ajou University, South Korea, invites applications for an extraordinary faculty member, non-tenured track, to begin September, 2011. Candidates should possess a doctorate in Management (Organization/HR) and/or relevant disciplines such as psychology or sociology with teaching and research experience in an applied area: Cross-cultural Management, Intercultural Management, Behavioral Management, or Industrial/Organizational/Social Psychology.
